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Forward



The test of Emergency Preparedness plans can virtually be done on occurrence of real disaster. But it is not prudent to wait for real disaster to happen which results into astronomical loss of lives and economy for testing the actual Disaster Preparedness Plans. Rationally, theory can be taught in a class room setting to School Children but in order to really test and train the theory, simulations and mockups are indispensable techniques to give disaster responders a flavor of the actual disaster. Mock Exercise provides virtually the only means, short of a real incident, of gauging the situation of testing and readiness of the effectiveness of an emergency response Plan. This effort of School Safety Cell Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education (DoE& SE) Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with the Technical and Financial support from UNICEF have assisted the District Education of the province to have an efficient system for responding to both natural and man-made disasters including Evacuation Plans through Emergency Preparedness Plans. School Safety Cell Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education (DoE& SE) Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with the Technical and Financial support from UNICEF is the provincial platform working in core areas; promotion of DRR teaching and learning, provision of safe school learning and promotion of school safety and Disaster Risk Reduction is also committed to make School Children and Teachers of the province Prepared towards disasters. School Safety Cell DoE&SE have been carried out Mock Exercises in all 35 districts of the province with the support of range of institutions i-e UNICEF, District Education Office and Rescue 1122, that all have played a major role in terms of identification of Vulnerable schools, Execution and monitoring of Mock Drills Exercises at District level. The mock Drill Exercise continued simultaneously in 400 schools, 12(06 boys and 06 girls) in each district for a period of 1 month i-e 11 October, to 26th October, 2021 in which 247,079 school children (125,693 boys and 121,386 girls) 4,139 teachers (2,187 Male, 1,952 Female) and 1257 PTC members (631 Male, 626 Female) actively participated from all over the province. The aim of "Mock Drills Exercise" is to guide the School Children and Teachers on strategies for conducting mock exercises by themselves in the utmost professional manners with objectivity. I am sure that this Mock Exercise enable the School Community to live up to the expectations of School Safety Cell. I wish to express my foremost appreciation for bringing out this Mock Drills Exercise for the purpose of making Disaster Resilient School more effective and efficient.

Executive Summary:

This report covers Mock Drills Exercise on Emergency Management carried out during 27th September to 27th October 2021. The School Safety Cell, Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education (SSC-DoE&SE) Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has organized Mock Drills Exercise with the Technical and Financial support from UNICEF. The Mock Drills Exercise were conducted through our partner Rescue 1122 in the light of notification from the Worthy Director General Rescue 1122 in 12 Vulnerable schools (06 Boys and 06 girls) in all 35 Districts of the Province. To conduct this activity efficiently and effectively District Focal Persons were nominated through District Education Office notified from the worthy Director E &SE KP. Stakeholders were engaged by holding meetings with Health Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Rescue 1122, Alkhidmat, PRCS, Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education (DoE&SE KP) and UNICEF on Designing of First Aid Box for Mock Drills Exercise. On October 6th and 7th, 2021 orientation sessions were organized for notified District Focal Persons on Strategy of Mock Drills Exercise followed by Distribution of 422 First Aid Boxes i-e 12 First Aid boxes for each district (6 each for boys and girls school), 36 Jackets (6 each for boys and girls school), 36 Face Masks (6 each for boys and girls school). Overall students 247,079 (125,693 boys and 121,386 girls) , 4,139 teachers (2,187 Male, 1,952 Female) and 1257 PTC members (631 Male , 626 Female) practically participated in Mock Drills Exercise and were trained on the process of Early warning, Triage, First Aid, Search and Rescue, Safe Evacuation, and monitoring. Each of 420 schools have developed Emergency Preparedness Plans including Evacuation Plans and assembly points. The District Focal Persons have given a work plan to organize the Mock Drills Exercise in these school involving all teaching staff, supporting staff and school children.

Introduction:

The design and conduct of Mock Drills Exercise is part of the words into Action Guideline series on Practical implementation of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction adopted by UN Members States in 2015 calls for substantive reduction of disaster risk and loss by 2030. Among its 4 priorities for action, the priority 4 Component on enhancing disaster preparedness for effective response highlights the strengthening Disaster Preparedness for effective response.

Pakistan has a rich history of terrible incidents of student casualties during earthquakes, floods and other emergency situations in schools. The 2005 earthquake killed 18,000 children and 900 teachers, destroyed approximately 7,489 schools, the APS terrorist attack killed 149 students and teachers and the century flood 2010, damaged more than 10,000 schools are the evidences to the fact. To respond efficiently and effectively in any future emergency Situation, it is of extreme importance that the School Children and Teachers should be properly trained and prepare on Emergency Management. Due to such catastrophic scenario Pakistan in common and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in particular have high vulnerability of education infrastructure and services towards natural disasters.

A Mock Drill is the testing of the efficacy of Disaster Management Plan. It is a participatory method to practice the safety-related measures and evacuation of the building during emergency situation. It enhances the ability to respond faster, better and in an organized manner during the response phase.

The School Safety Cell (SSC) has undertaken the program of institutionalizing School Safety, DRR measures and improving the resilience in schools of Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education (DoE &SE) Government Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with the Technical and Financial support of UNICEF since 2017, to increase the preparedness of Education System to cope with any emergency situation from top to the bottom level and level of Education managers, school teachers and students throughout the schools in the province.

Children in schools are the most vulnerable during disasters. A safe and secure environment is a prerequisite for any school, where ensuring safety of children, teachers and supporting staff during disasters is of outmost necessary. Thus, to ensure safety of children in disasters and also to promote faster rehabilitation post disaster, School Safety Cell Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education (DoE &SE) Government Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with the Technical and Financial support from UNICEF has developed a School Safety Mock Drills capsule wherein within its ambit measures like awareness generation, ensuring communication, school Emergency Preparedness plans, Evacuation Plans, capacity building of students and teachers on First Aid, rehearsals and Mock Drills etc is highlighted.

AIM:

The aim of conducting mock exercises is to assist the District Education offices of the province in building inclusive capacity to competently prevent, mitigate, or prepare the aftermath of any disaster applying standardized, pre-prepared tools, with pre-trained, pre-designated Focal Persons, Teachers and School Children using the available resources/equipment's.

Objective

The objective of Mock Drills Exercise is to develop competencies of the School Children and Teachers to various forms of disasters through preventive activities, tasked to conduct safe evacuation during a disaster, while ensure the schools to form permanent Emergency Preparedness Plans & teams at schools:

- To Support and sensitize school community on Safety measures and Coordinated Emergency Response Mechanism through Mock Drills.
- To create a safe environment for children.
- Constituting/review school Emergency Preparedness Plan.
- To Facilitate, resource and evacuation mapping to the assembly points.
- Training school Children, teachers and supporting staff on First Aid.
- Hazard, vulnerability and risk analysis in each school.

Purpose:

This strategy of Mock Drills Exercise shall be a living document. The purpose of this Mock Exercise is to establish the procedure and strategy for conducting the Mock Exercise in all schools of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. This activity shall provide direction and assigns responsibility to the Nominated District Focal Persons of School Safety Cell to organize Mock Drills Exercise regularly in their schools.


This entire activity was designed by School Safety Cell DoE&SE and were responsible to keep close coordination with stakeholders both at provincial and District Level.

This Mock Exercise at each district was conducted with the technical support of Rescue 1122 and PRCS volunteers.



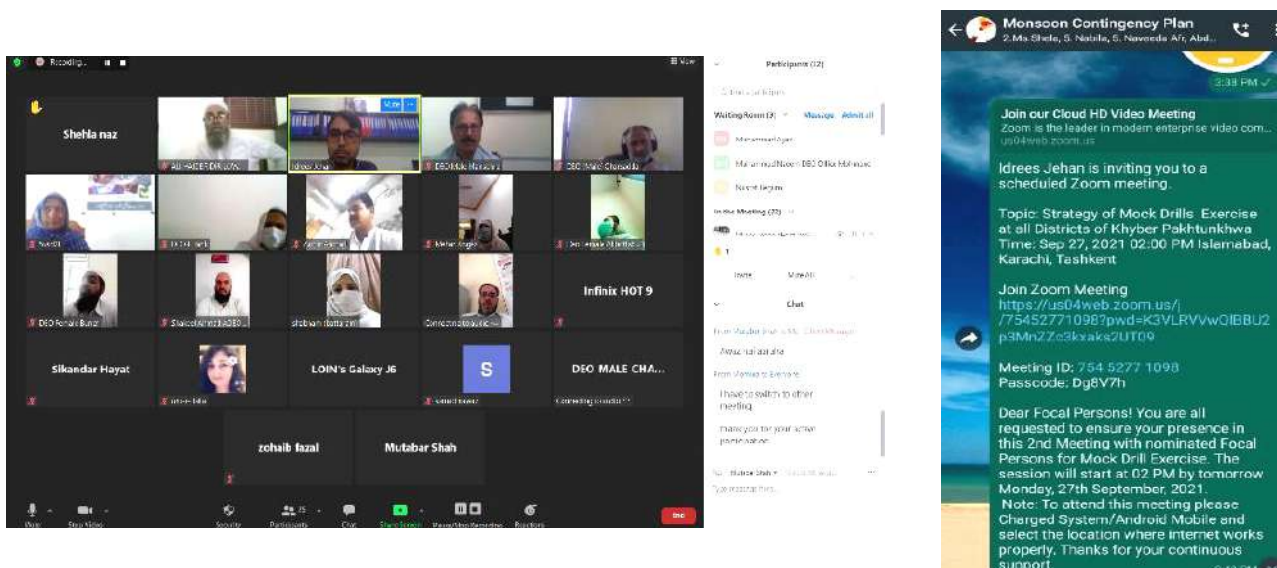
Process of Mock Drills Exercise

Process of Mock Drills Exercise:

The process of Mock Drills Exercise formally commenced from 2nd July and ended on 27th October, 2021 in the targeted 421 schools with the Technical support o Rescue 1122. To accomplish this task, the following activities were successfully organized both at Provincial and Districts level;

Zoom Meetings:

On July 2nd 2021 an online zoom meeting was conducted with District Focal Persons on the Concept, purpose and need of Mock Drills Exercise. Similarly, on September 27th 2021 second online zoom meeting was successfully conducted on Selection criteria of vulnerable schools and Strategy of Mock Drill Exercise.

Selection Criteria of vulnerable schools:

The overall target of Mock Drills Exercise was 421 vulnerable schools of all 35 districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 12 Schools from each district (06 boys and 06 girls). Initially a well-defined criterion was developed for the selection of Vulnerable Schools.

- i. Schools that were vulnerable or affected by natural disasters such floods, earthquake, landslide and erosion
- ii. Schools physically located in vulnerable areas/sites such as torrents, steep slopes and riverine belts.
- iii. Having a high ranking for natural disasters in light of the historical disasters frequency and intensity
- iv. Schools which are climatically vulnerable to thunderstorms, hailstorms, landslides and cloud bursts.

- v. The schools should have ground for Mock Drill Exercise.
- vi. The selected school should be functional who will regularly organize Mock Drills Exercise in their school.

Notification of Focal Persons:

The nominated 02 District Focal Persons (01 Male and 01 Female) were notified on 30th September, 2021 by the worthy Director Elementary and Secondary Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Hafiz Dr. Muhammad Ibrahim. The List and the role and responsibilities of District Focal Persons are attached in **Annexure-C**

Pre- Exercise Orientation meeting:

First two days' pre-exercise orientation meeting was held at Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education (DoE&SE) Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on 6th and 7th October, 2021 which was attend by all notified District Focal Persons and relevant stakeholders. During the meeting following discussion were made:

School Safety Cell DoE&SE Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has conducted Mock Drills Exercise in 400 School(boys/girls) through MOU with Rescue 1122 Khyber Pakhtunkhwa which is the reliable institution for Mock Drill Exercise followed by coordination meetings by District Focal Person with District Emergency Officer Rescue 1122. The Mock Drills Exercises commenced simultaneously in all 35 Districts of the Province supported by well-defined agenda see **Annexure- E**.

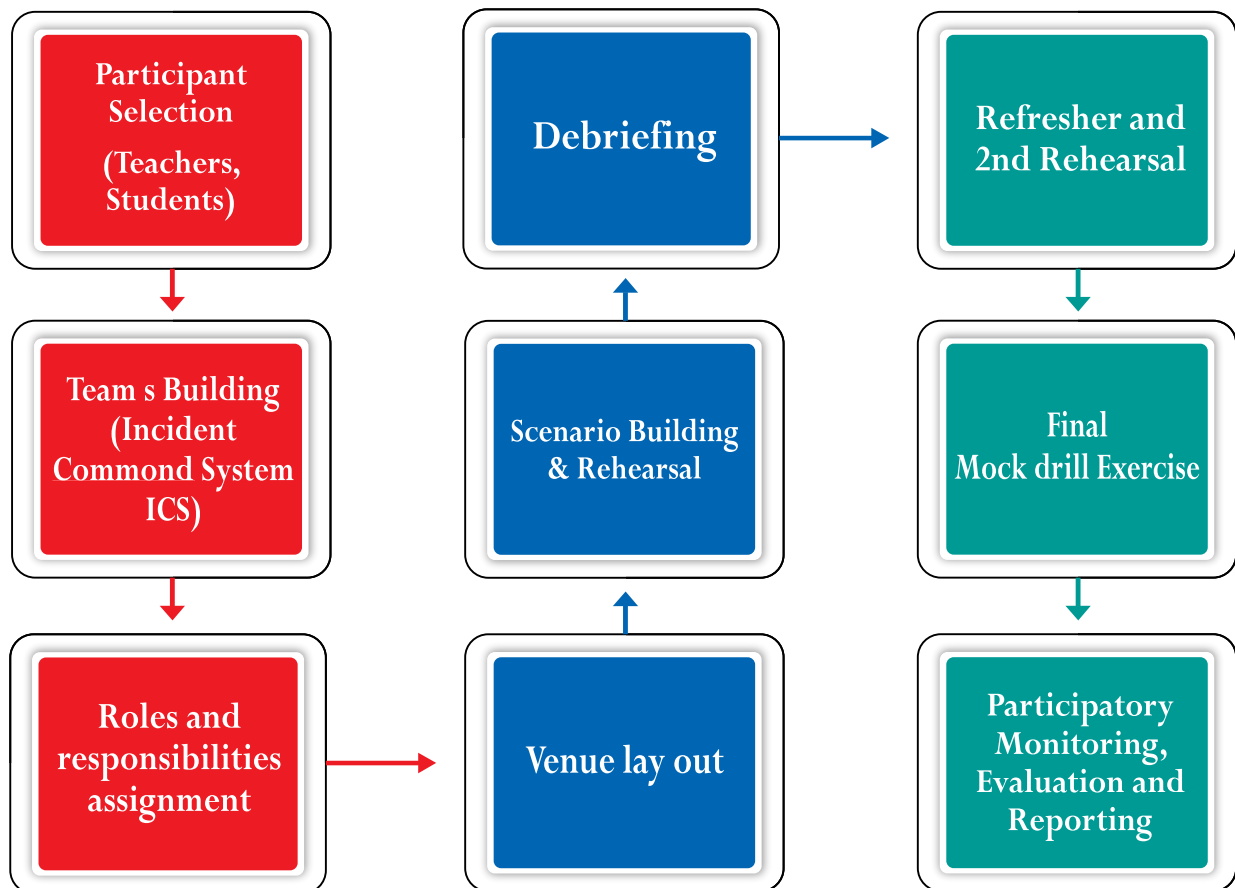

Strategy

Strategy:

For effective and coordinated implementation a well-defined Mock Drills Exercise strategy was designed and shared with Rescue 1122 which was followed in all Districts of the Province. The strategy was follow,



- Selected Suitable participants i-e Teachers and Students who have actively participated in the Mock Exercise.
- The entire school was involved in Mock Drill Exercise however, six teams were formulated to accomplish the task including Early warning, Triage, First Aid, Search and Rescue, Safe Evacuation, and monitoring.
- Guided the teams on available tools and equipment's i-e First Aid and their role and responsibilities
- Venue was selected for Mock Drill Exercise in each school.
- The scenario and rehearsal was built with the support of selected teams and
- The debriefing was conducted and removed the deficiency
- The second rehearsal was conducted to bring coordination and efficacy
- The entire school practically participated in the Final Mock Drill exercise properly monitored, evaluated by Directorate of E&SE, School Safety Cell staff, District Education Officer, District Focal Person, Rescue 1122 experts and PRCS volunteers.

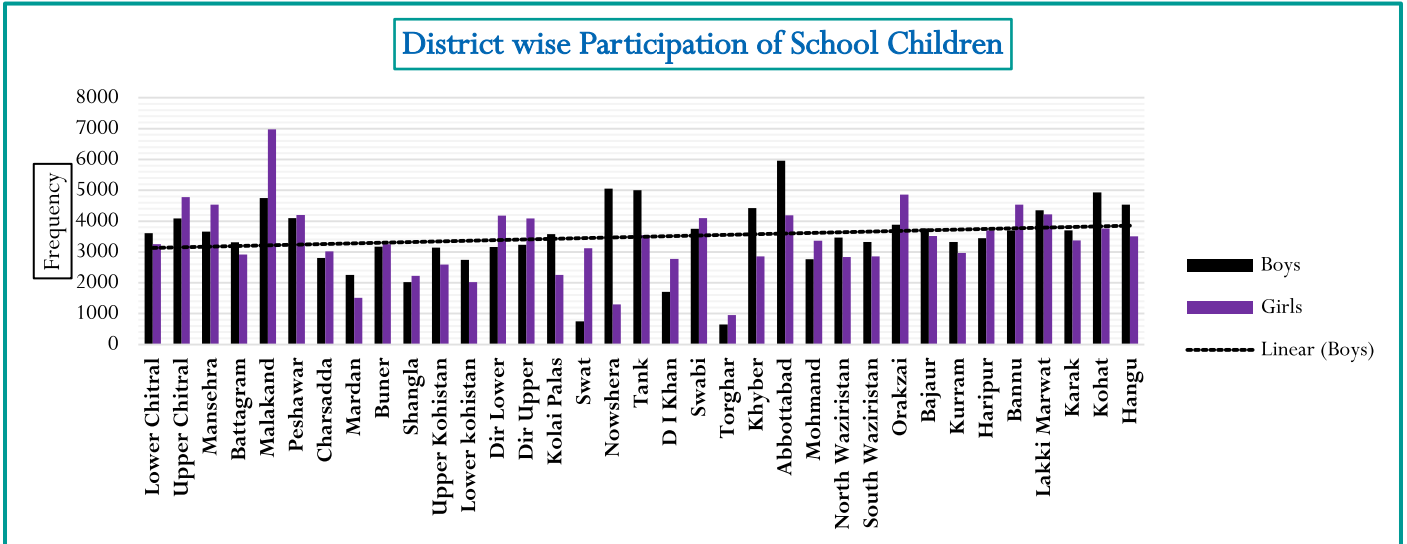
Participation

District wise participation of School Children:

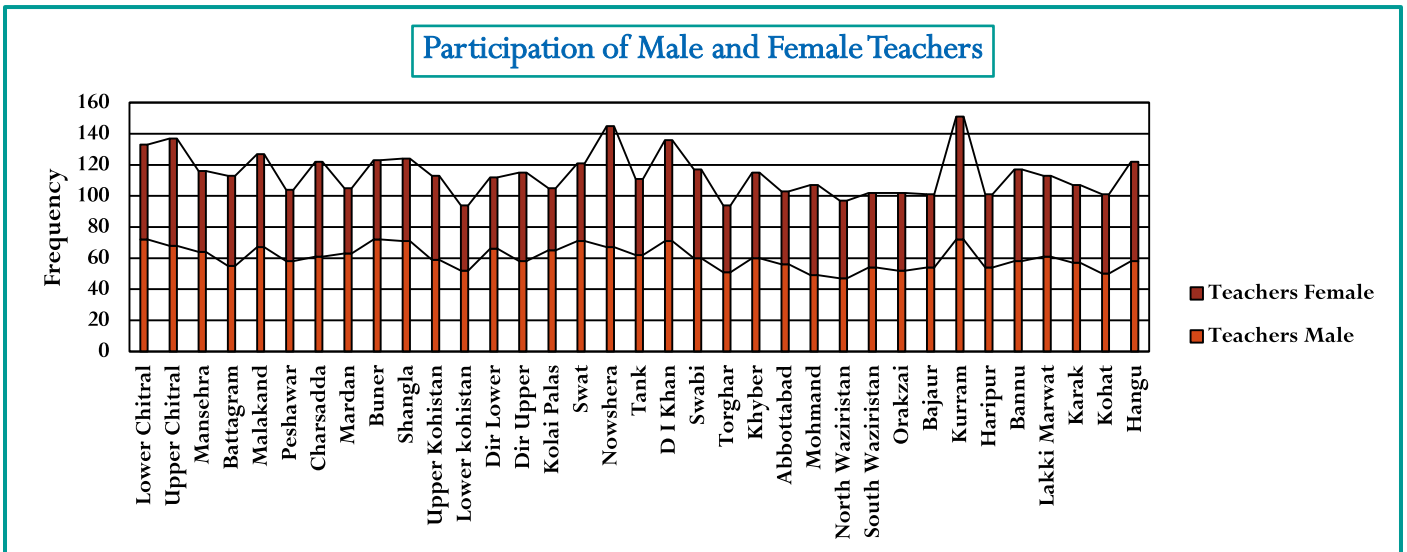

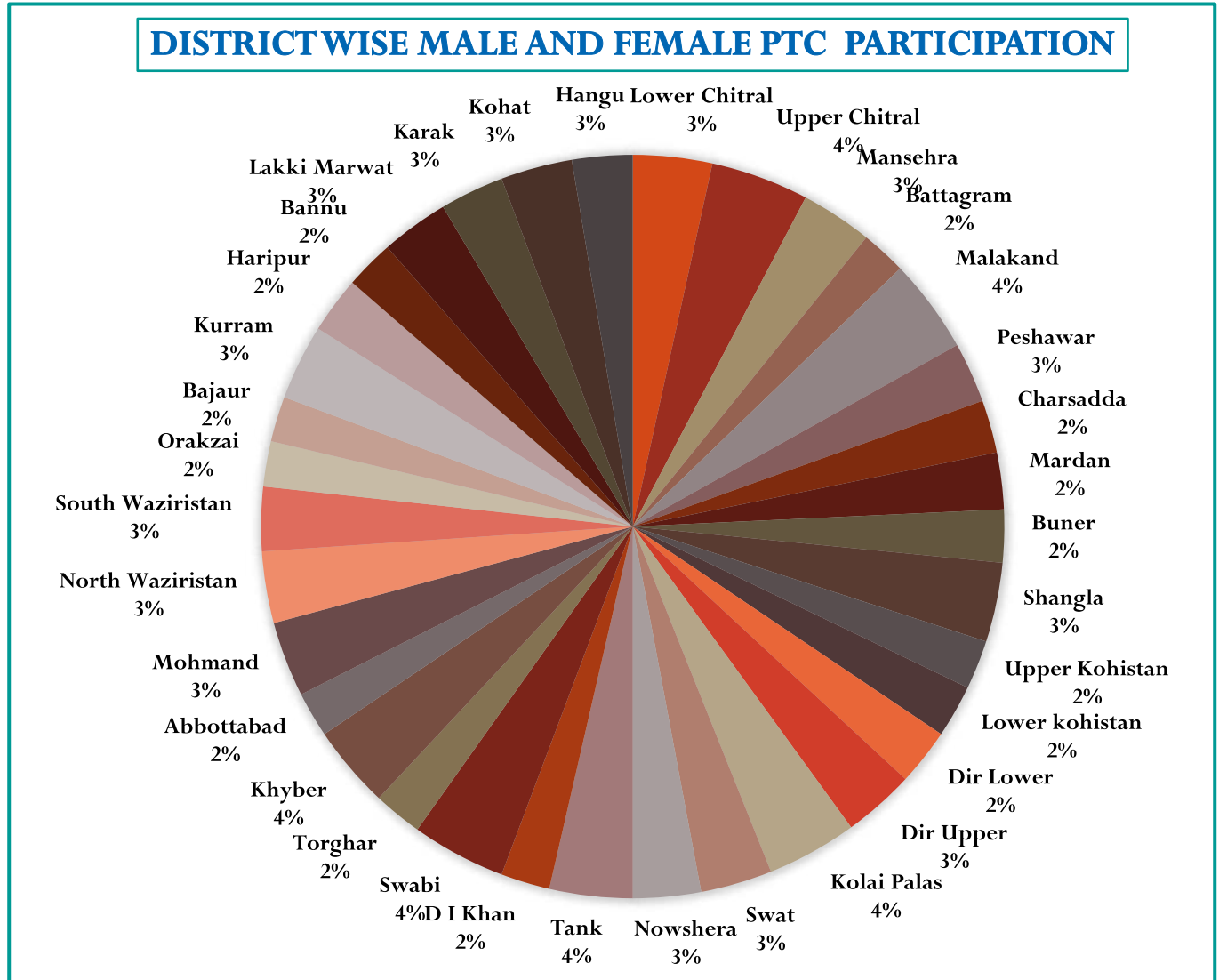
District wise Participation of Teachers:

Various Steps for Conduct of Mock Drills Exercise

Various Steps for Conduct of Mock Drills Exercise:

The Mock Exercises commenced with the recitation of the Holy Quran followed by the welcome address of District Focal Person. Technical support in Mock Exercises including briefing, groups formation their role and responsibilities and final Mock Drill activity was facilitated by district Rescue 1122 team.

As per agenda the following topics were covered:

A. Awareness session on COVID-19 and Vaccination:

The District Focal Person(Male/Female) has conducted awareness session on COVID-19 and vaccination comprising Face Mask, Hand washing, Health and Hygiene, social distancing in all targeted schools

B. Orientation On First Aid:

Prior the commencement of Mock Exercise the Rescue 1122 team orient the entire school children and teachers on Importance, need and on effective utilization of available First Aid Box.

C. Conduct of Mock Drills Exercise:

The Mock Drills Exercise were planned and executed in the following methodology.

- **Step-I Formation of Groups:**

The entire school strength, teaching and non-teaching staff were involved in all mock exercises. However, as per standard seven teams were formulated and were guided on their role and responsibilities.

- **Step-2 Early Warning (EW) Team:**

Early warning is the provision of timely and effective information, through the identified institutions, that allows individual exposed to hazard to take measures to minimize their risk and prepare for effective response (L Macfadyen, L. P. et. al., 2010).

This team comprised of 6 children and provided timely and effective information as per scenario in each district. This team disseminated and communicated the known channel i-e megaphone or bell understandable to school children.

- **Step-3 Victim Team:**

This is the affected team whom were guided on their role and responsibilities. In Mock Drills Exercise these children practically played role of injured, dead and others.

- **Step-4 Evacuation Team:**

This team has given clean instructions that on activation of Early Warning everyone is required to evacuate the building to the nearest assembly point. During evacuation this team guided the children to the assembly point.

- **Step-5 Counting of missing children:**

After evacuation the incident command counted all the evacuated children to find out the missing children

- **Step-6 Search and Rescue Team:**

Search and rescue are almost performed in order, yet they are separate operations. The school children in this team identified the living victims. The children physically removed occupants or victim from the danger. The children used different methods for rescue of victims i-e Rescues with one Rescuer, more than two rescuers, Search and rescue during adverse conditions, Stretcher and casualty transportation.

- **Step-7 Triage Team:**

During Triage this team conducted the following activities;

- Prioritized among the victims who need critical attention and immediate transportation to the hospital and those with less serious injuries.
- The children in this team started this step before transportation become available.
- This team used 04 different colours i-e red for acute danger for life, yellow for severe injury, green for minor injury, blue for no or small chance of survival and black for deceased.

Based on triage this team has given immediate assistance or help to a casualty/ affected child. This team continued their help during transportation till a doctor took charge of the affected child.

The incident Command monitored the sequence of Mock Drill Exercise. However, Directorate, UNICEF, District Education officers, District Focal Persons, Rescue 1122 teams and School Safety Cell Staff regularly evaluated mock drills exercise in different districts.

Impacts of Mock Drills Exercise

Impacts of Mock Drills Exercise:

The Mock Drills Exercise for Vulnerable school's children have aims to optimize effective and efficient Emergency Response, and have resulted in the following outcomes:

❖ **Hazard Vulnerability Appropriate:**

The Mock Drills Exercise being conducted in the face of primary hazard each district.

❖ **Dynamic Emergency Preparedness plans:**

The Mock Drills Exercise are ensuring that each school at district level has developed their separate Emergency Preparedness Plan and Evacuation plan in the light of associated risks.

❖ **Resource awareness:**

The District Education Offices and the school management were clearly guided on how to full fill the consumable materials from PTC fund.

❖ **Greater stakeholder synergy:**
